House Passes Bill to Ensure Military Children Receive Fair Education Enrollment

I am a prime co-sponsor of House Bill 1094. I was the prime sponsor of similar legislation last session.

Our servicemembers' children should not face extra educational hurdles as their parent moves from one assignment to another. This bill would make it easier for these kids to enroll in new schools in the Commonwealth. The bill now heads to the Senate.

Mackenzie Instrumental in Bringing Funding to Lower Saucon Ball Fields

Each year the Local Share Account (LSA) Program for Northampton County and the Monroe County - Contiguous Counties LSA Program are awarded to projects in Northampton County and some counties north of there.

This year, I made sure the project in Lower Saucon Township received nearly \$510,000 of the available funds for the redevelopment of the ball fields in the township.

This is excellent news for the district and a much needed investment to keep our sporting facilities functional and active for the all the people in and around the Lower Saucon community.

Providing Assistance to Area Veterans

Continuing to provide additional aid to area seniors and veterans, my Bethlehem district office has been scheduling veteran assistance hours each month.

These service hours are held on the fourth Wednesday of the month, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at 1425 Mountain Drive N. in Bethlehem.

Services for veterans and their dependents include assistance with compensation, pension and death benefits; education and health care; and other benefits. Veterans do not need a membership with the American Legion to receive these services.
